In addition to playing a large role in laying the groundwork for economic development, CPL has also been involved with the planning and design of public water supplies to many areas of the County, includ-

ing 90 miles of new water main, 6 water storage tanks and 5 pump stations. The most influential known as the Genesee County Water Supply Program almost 20 years ago, which made public water available to many of the municipalities in the County. CPL is currently involved with Phase 2 of the Program, intended to supply another 2.5 million gallons of water per day to homes and businesses.
